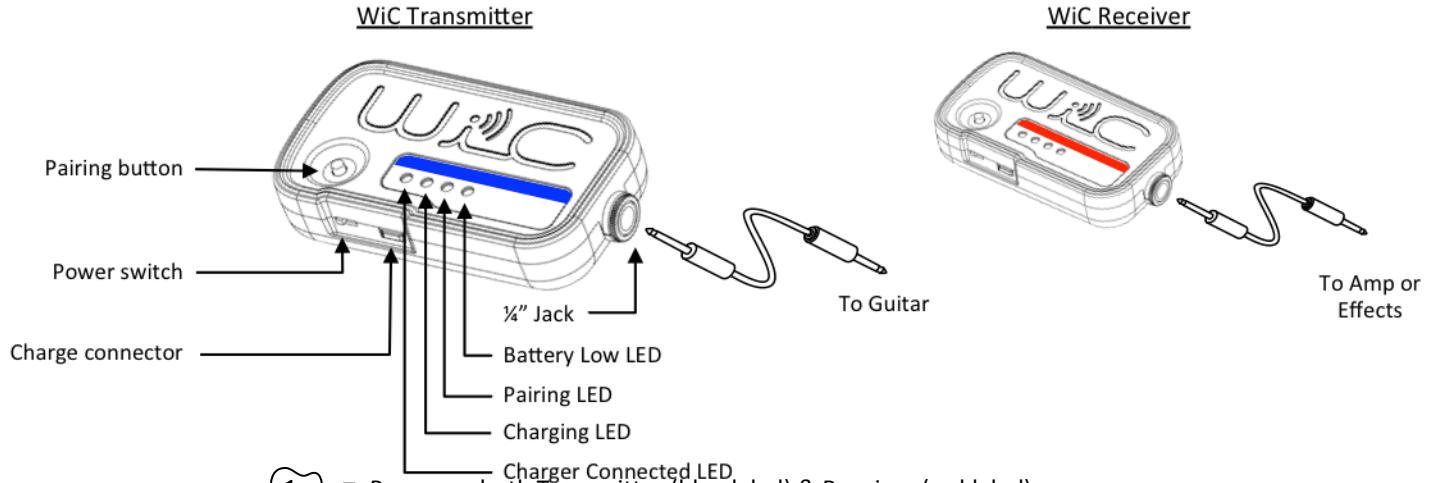


## WiC for Guitar: 30 seconds to freedom!



**1** Power on both Transmitter (blue label) & Receiver (red label)  
– Flashing blue means you need to pair the devices.

**2** Press pairing button on both (you have 10 seconds)  
– The blue lights will turn solid when they are paired.

**3** Use the 1-meter cable with your guitar to transmitter, and the 1.8-meter cable from receiver to your amp.

**4** Play your instrument!

- 1 - WiC Receiver
- 1 - Dual USB charger
- 2 - USB charging cables
- 1 - 1 meter guitar cable
- 1 - 1.8 meter amp cable
- 1 - Holster for the WiC Transmitter

### Hints:

- The Dual USB Charger will let you charge both devices at the same time in about 2½ hours (solid green indicates a full charge). The charge will give you up to 20 hours of use. WiCs charge fast and you don't have to fully charge them before each use! 15-30 minutes of charge gets you lots of playing time.
- WiC has a range of up to 500 feet, depending on environmental conditions like weather, terrain and buildings.
- Experiment with where to place the receiver – straight into your amp or sound mixer, or as the first device in your pedal board.
- Keep receivers at least three feet from each other.
- WiC Transmitter will sleep if no audio is present to save power. It wakes up automatically.
- WiC automatically finds the most interference-free channel – but you'll do better by placing the WiC away from noisy electronics like your phone or amp. If you hear noise, move the WiC a foot or so and it will go away.
- WIC transmitters and receivers are interchangeable. Any one transmitter can pair with any one receiver.
